Judicial Review as a Remedy in Tax Disputes

Appeals to the tax tribunals are the way most taxpayers seek redress (because, usually, there is no alternative). But sometimes an appeal is not competent, or will not give you the remedy you want. In those circumstances judicial review should be considered. This talk will cover the following topics, with references to recent tax cases by way of illustration;

- What is judicial review and where can I get it?
- What can it do for me that an appeal can't?
- How do I know which one to choose?
- Is it a case of either appeal or review, or might I need both?
- How quickly do I need to act?
- What is the procedure and how long will it take? How much is it likely to cost?
